**Sweetie Pies Bakery finds a way to make life a little sweeter
for children and families affected by cancer**

Last year’s event raised more than \$120,000 for **CancerCare for Kids**.

“Cupcakes for a Cause is a great way to have a sweet treat while helping children affected by this devastating illness,” said Diane Blum, executive director of **CancerCare**. “Children diagnosed with cancer, and those who have a parent or sibling with cancer, face very difficult emotional questions and concerns that most kids their age don’t have. Our oncology-trained social workers help children understand cancer, talk about their feelings and become less afraid.”
